Congratulations! ASIAN COMMUNITY NURSING HOME has been identified by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) as one of the highest-performing nursing homes in California. This means your nursing home is in the top 10 percent of the National Nursing Home Composite Quality Measure, which is a commendable achievement.

As a representative of a high-performing nursing home, **you (or a nominee) are eligible to become a “peer coach” within the California Nursing Home Quality Care Collaborative (NHQCC)** run by Health Services Advisory Group (HSAG), the Medicare Quality Improvement Organization for California. The role of a peer coach is to inspire and share best practices among nursing homes to improve quality of care for residents.

Your nursing home’s eligibility to join the California NHQCC peer coaching network is based on your quality composite score measure of **3.82**. These data, which reflect the six-month period from February to July 2014, were provided to HSAG from the October 2014 Nursing Home Composite Measure Report developed by Telligen, the Quality Innovation Network National Coordinating Center under contract with CMS.
